Parks honored with leadership award for work in Baptist institutions

Alva G. Parks of Montgomery was recently awarded the Distinguished Leadership Award from the Baptist Association of Christian Educators. The award is a result of the many years Parks worked with religious education in Baptist churches and universities. Parks and his wife, Doris, are members of First Baptist Church, Montgomery, where he served as minister of education from 1958 to 1971. Parks remembers his years at First, Montgomery, fondly. "In Montgomery, we saw how the quality of leadership improved because people were willing to be trained," he said. "We sort of pioneered in leader training which became a conventionwide program known as Baptist Association of Christian Educators." Later, he became president of the group, and he now serves on the board of directors. The couple have served in several vicinities during their 49 years of marriage. Feeling called into the ministry at a young age, Parks thought he would eventually become a pastor. After earning his B.A. from Georgetown College, Georgetown, Ky., he attended Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Ky., where he earned a master's degree in divinity. "It was not until I got to seminary that I realized I was being called into religious education," Parks said. He later returned to school to earn his doctorate from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas. Along with serving as a minister of education, Parks also taught at Southwestern Seminary for 11 years. He also served as executive vice president of Dallas Baptist University, where he currently is the senior advisor to the president. Additionally, Parks has served as a trustee of LifeWay Christian Resources, and both Parks and his wife have served as education consultants to the European Baptist Convention. Upon retirement, the couple moved back to Montgomery, where the two are active in their Sunday School class, sing in the senior adult choir and are members of several church committees. Parks volunteers as a chaplain at Baptist Medical Center and serves on two committees for Baptist World Alliance. Parks believes that the education programs in churches are vital. "As the training goes in the church, so the church goes," he said. "I think education is absolutely essential for the growth and development of the church." His advice to young people who are considering a career in religious education is to follow God's leadership and harbor a willing spirit. "First of all, you should have a calling," he said.

700 FARM ACRES UP FOR REZONING IN JESSAMINE LAND WOULD BE USED FOR HOUSING

NICHOLASVILLE -- A proposed rezoning and annexation of more than 700 acres of farmland would add more than 1,700 single family homes to the Jessamine County seat.

In a public hearing on Monday night, the Nicholasville Planning Commission is scheduled to consider two separate rezonings; one involving 134 acres owned by Geneva Ethington, and the other involving 588 acres owned by heirs to the estate of the late U.S. District Court Judge Bernard Moynahan and his wife, Mary Thomas Parks Moynahan. The judge and his wife both died in 1999.

Both properties are now zoned for agricultural use and are off Ky. 39, also known as Sulphur Well Road, southeast of Nicholasville. The Nicholasville City Commission passed an intent-to-annex ordinance for both properties in December.

The Moynahan property would be developed into 1,251 residential lots,

according to preliminary plans on file in the planning commission office. Another 29 lots would be zoned for industry.

The Ethington property would be zoned for 466 residential lots, according to plans.

Bruce Smith, the Nicholasville attorney who represents Ethington, wrote in a letter on file that even if the property is rezoned, she would not develop the property for another five years.

The properties are in an area of growing development pressure. A new high school opened on Nicholasville's east side three years ago to ease overcrowding. And the state plans to buy rights of way for a proposed U.S. 27 bypass around Nicholasville's eastern edge. Judge Moynahan was a member of a citizens advisory committee looking for potential routes for the bypass at the time of his death.

BERNARD T. MOYNAHAN JR., 1918-1999

Bernard T. Moynahan Jr., former chief judge of the U.S. Eastern District of Kentucky, died yesterday at St. Joseph Hospital. He was 80.

Mr. Moynahan, who had a history of heart trouble, experienced chest pains at his Nicholasville law office and went into respiratory arrest while being driven to the hospital by his law partner, David Irvin.

Mr. Moynahan was sworn in as a federal judge on Nov. 22, 1963, just moments before President John F. Kennedy, who had appointed him, was assassinated. Mr. Moynahan became chief judge in 1974 and stepped down from the lifetime appointment to the federal bench in 1984.

In between, he presided over several notable cases, including a five-year special grand jury investigation into state government that included the terms of former governors Wendell Ford and Julian Carroll.

The two special grand juries that were involved in the investigation returned indictments against nine people but not Ford or Carroll.

In 1975, Mr. Moynahan decided to imprison activist Jill Raymond for her refusal to answer questions by a federal grand jury investigating members of the Weather Underground, a group of radical activists, who had reportedly sought refuge in Lexington.

Mr. Moynahan noted that his ruling was affirmed throughout Raymond's appeals. Even the nation's two most liberal Supreme Court justices, William O. Douglas and Thurgood Marshall, turned down her appeals, he said in a 1984 interview.

Mr. Moynahan often quoted Shakespeare from memory at length from the bench. One clerk said he had the ability to remember the volume and page number of a case he hadn't read for years.

In announcing his retirement, Mr. Moynahan, an avid horseman, gentleman farmer, pilot and political observer, said he wanted time to pursue other interests. He also indicated that he wanted to return to private practice.

Mr. Moynahan was a partner in the Nicholasville law firm Moynahan, Irvin & Smith at his death.

"Down here (in Jessamine County) they thought he walked on water, and

they may have been right. He enjoyed just being a country lawyer. He was a very good one," said a shaken Irvin.

"He was just one of those great judges," said Judge Eugene Siler Jr., judge of the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals and a longtime friend, who considered Mr. Moynahan a mentor. "He was just a wonderful person to be around. He was extremely bright."

"He worked hard in the early years when he and Judge (Mac) Swinford were the only judges in Eastern Kentucky. ... It about worked him to death. He had to cover all of Eastern Kentucky, from Lexington to Frankfort to London to Jackson to Pikeville, then to Catlettsburg."

Siler said that Mr. Moynahan and Swinford taught him how to be a judge.

"Everybody admired Judge Moynahan for his intellectual capacity. But he knew about the common person and the feelings of Kentuckians," Siler said.

Said Irvin, who was a law clerk and federal magistrate under Mr. Moynahan before he became his law partner: "He was like a father to me. He taught me everything I know about being a lawyer."

Said former governor and U.S. senator Ford: "In all the time that he served I thought he was honorable, tough but fair, and he always worked to help the judicial system. He always worked to help the system itself and prepare the judges to render the kind of justice that all Americans expect."

Mr. Moynahan, born Dec. 29, 1918, in Akron, Ohio, graduated with honors from Nicholasville High School at 13. He graduated cum laude, with a bachelor's degree in ancient languages, from the University of Kentucky in 1935, when he was 16. In 1938, when he was 19, he graduated with honors from the UK College of Law. He was the youngest person to graduate from the UK law school. He had to get special permission to take the bar exam because of his age, and was not allowed to practice law until he turned 21. He was admitted to practice Jan. 2, 1940, just days after his 21st birthday.

Mr. Moynahan served in the Army Air Corps from 1942 to 1946, and spent part of that time as a prisoner of war in Germany during World War II.

He was a bomber-navigator on a B-17 Flying Fortress, and was shot down Feb. 21, 1944. He spent 16 months in a prison camp.

Toward the end of the war, as Germany was starting to disintegrate and Russian soldiers were approaching, the Germans abandoned the prison.

Mr. Moynahan and another prisoner "liberated" two bicycles and rode to France, Irvin said.

Irvin said Mr. Moynahan talked a lot about World War II, including about spending the winter trying to trap a crow because the only food he was given as a prisoner was turnips and bread. He caught the crow, but it tasted terrible, Mr. Moynahan told Irvin.

Mr. Moynahan and other prisoners also tried repeatedly to tunnel out of the prison, but each time they thought they were going to succeed, they came face to face with German guards and dogs. The prisoners discovered after the Germans abandoned the prison that the Germans had crude seismographs and knew all along where the prisoners were and what they were up to, Irvin said.

Mr. Moynahan was U.S. attorney for the Eastern District of Kentucky from 1961 until he became a federal judge.

He was Jessamine County attorney from 1946 to 1954 and a Jessamine County election commissioner from 1960 to 1961.

He received the Kentucky Bar Association Outstanding Service Award in

1974 and the Fayette County Bar Association Outstanding Service Award in 1984.

He received special recognition from Kentucky Academy of Trial Lawyers for service to bench and bar in 1984.
